ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

A learning management system (LMS) is a software application for the administration, documentation, tracking, reporting and delivery of educational courses. Moodle is a free and open-source learning management system (LMS), designed to create private website filled with dynamic courses. Moodle was originally developed by Martin Dougiamas to help educators create online courses with a focus on interaction and collaborative construction of content.

The word "Moodle" is originally an acronym for Modular Object-Oriented Dynamic Learning Environment. Anyone who uses Moodle is a Moodler. Moodle is used for blended learning, distance education, flipped classroom and other e-learning projects. MOODLE platform can be used to create MOOC (Massive open online course).

MOODLE is an open source learning management system (LMS) that facilitates all activities from registering a student to the award of a grade at the end of a semester. It can be used for courses offered in all formats like face to face, online and blended mode. MOODLE provides to create a course website and access control. It provides an easy way to upload and share materials, hold online discussions and chats, give quizzes and surveys, gather and review assignments, and record grades.

MOODLE is a web application that runs on a server, and is accessed by using a web browser. A 'course' in MOODLE is an area where a teacher will add resources (static content) to read and activities (interactive content) for their students to complete. It might be a simple page with downloadable documents or it might be a complex set of tasks where learning progresses through interactions.

OBJECTIVE

This training programme on MOODLE aims at facilitating teachers of Higher Education programs to create and conduct courses as instructors using MOODLE. This program also provides support and hands on training on features of MOODLE, and how these features can be applied to teaching and learning, and eventually become administrators of the site.

EXPECTED OUTCOME

- ✦ Understand the role of LMS in the conduct of a course
- ✦ Set up the teacher profile, enroll students to a course and manage the course space
- ✦ Add resources to a course including files (Text, pdf, Audio files, Video files and Images)
- ✦ Add interactive resources (Assignments, Choice, Quiz, Forum, Chat, etc)
- ✦ Create question banks and conduct online exams (Multiple Choice, Numerical, Short Answer, True/False) using MOODLE.
- ✦ Enhance knowledge on a wide range of online text books, video recorded lectures, YouTube clips, powerpoint slides, animations, digital diagrams and graphics
- ✦ To adopt new educational changes without compromising the quality of education
- ✦ Use Moodle Mobile App
