About the programme

A learning management system (LMS) is a software application for the administration, documentation, tracking, reporting and delivery of educational courses. Moodle is a free and open-source learning management system (LMS), designed to create private website filled with dynamic courses. Moodle was originally developed by Martin Dougiamas to help educators create online courses with a focus on interaction and collaborative construction of content.

Moodle, acronym for "Modular Object-Oriented Dynamic Learning Environment" is an online educational platform that provides custom learning environments for students. It is used as a platform to create open online courses, helps in blended learning, distance education, flipped classroom and e-learning. Besides classroom lectures, teachers interact with students on many levels. These include enrolment in courses, roll call, supply of handouts, PowerPoint presentations, assignments, announcements, grade computation, feedback etc. MOODLE platform can be used to create MOOC (Massive open online course).

Moodle as an open source learning management system (LMS) facilitates all activities from registering a student to the award of a grade at the end of a semester. It provides a course website and an access control. It permits an easy way to upload and share materials, hold online discussions and chats, provide quizzes and surveys, gather and review assignments, and record grades.

The two-day national seminar & hands on training on blended teaching-learning through Moodle based Learning Management System (LMS) explores dynamic educational strategies in this digital era. This training programme on MOODLE aims at facilitating teachers of Higher Education programs to create and conduct courses as instructors using MOODLE. This program also provides support and hands on training on features of MOODLE, and how these features can be applied to teaching and learning, and eventually become administrators of the site.

Expected outcome of the programme :

- Understand the role of LMS in the conduct of a course
- Set up the teacher profile, enroll students to a course and manage the course space
- Add resources to a course including files (text, pdf, audio files, video files and images)
- Add interactive resources (assignments, Choice, quiz, forum, chat, etc)
- Create question banks and conduct online exams (multiple choice, numerical, short answer, true/false) using MOODLE.
- Use Moodle Mobile App.
