A learning management system (LMS) is a software application for the administration, documentation, tracking, reporting and delivery of educational courses.

MOODLE is an open source learning management system (LMS) that facilitates all activities from registering a student to the award of a grade at the end of a semester. It can be used for courses offered in all formats like face to face, online and blended mode. MOODLE provides to create a course website and access control. It provides an easy way to upload and share materials, hold online discussions and chats, give quizzes and surveys, gather and review assignments, and record grades.

At the end of the programme the participants should be able to;

- Understand the role of LMS in the conduct of a course
- Set up the teacher profile, enroll students to a course and manage the course space
- Add resources to a course including files (text, pdf, audio files, video files and images)
- Add interactive resources (assignments, Choice, quiz, forum, chat, etc)
- Create question banks and conduct online exams (multiple choice, numerical, short answer, true/false) using MOODLE.
- Use Moodle Mobile App.
